Tips on Keeping Culligan Quench Machines Sanitised Between PM Service Calls

- Wipe the entire exterior of the machine with a clean towel using non-abrasive disinfecting household cleaning spray.
- If your Culligan Quench machine has a drip tray, be sure to regularly empty the tray and wipe the interior and grill dry.
- Clean up any water around the base of the machine that may have spilled.

A Culligan Quench technician will perform a preventive maintenance service call yearly for water coolers and coffee brewers and two times a year for ice machines and most sparkling water coolers.
